

CHH contracts out freight deliveries

Carter Holt Harvey (CHH) has appointed a management company to oversee the provision of its freight delivery services following a comprehensive review.

Newly formed NeTloGiX will take up the contract with CHH in April 2013. Chairman and founder Paul Harper said NeTloGiX was an independent service provider with no transport assets.

CHH's current road transport carriers would "remain in the mix" as future service suppliers, he said.

A maritime transport logistics consultant, Mr Harper said he had been developing the NeTloGiX concept over several years and was assembling a team.

Dairy Transport Logistics chief executive Chinthaka Abeywickrama had been recruited to lead the new company.
